

Earning CEUs

Every year, medical office staff must adjust to changes in coding, reimbursement and compliance processes. Keeping your certification active requires an ongoing commitment to continuing education. Practice Management Institute® requires its graduates to complete Continuing Education Units (CEUs) to maintain active certification(s).

CEU REQUIREMENTS

PMI defines a CEU as one hour of participation in a recognized continuing education program. PMI graduates must obtain a minimum of 12 CEUs per year to maintain the active credential. At least 75% (9) of the required CEUs must be obtained through training that is directly relevant to the core competency requirements associated with the certificate. PMI will allow 25% (3) of the required CEUs to be earned from other training topics.

Teaching

Teaching at an accredited college, university or educational institution recognized by PMI? You may be eligible to apply 6 CEUs toward your PMI renewal requirement. Written verification of current teaching assignment(s) from the accredited school and a copy of the course syllabus are required. Relevant courses include topics that address the business of medicine and relate directly to the core competencies represented by the PMI credential.

LOW COST or NO COST OPTIONS

MULTIPLE CERTIFICATIONS

PMI graduates that have multiple certifications may apply CEUs from a single training to each certificate if the training met the requirements for each credential. For example, if you are certified in both CMC and CMOM, and you earn 3 CEUs at a coding program, you may apply the CEUs toward the CEU requirements of both certifications.

RANDOM AUDIT

PMI performs audits to verify that certified professionals have met the continuing education requirements associated with their credential(s). In the event that you are randomly selected for audit, PMI will contact you to request evidence of the CEUs claimed in the online CEU tracker. Please retain documentation of all of the CEUs you have earned for this purpose, and for your own records.
