

The Role of a PMI Professional Proctor

Candidates applying for the opportunity to become a Practice Management Institute (PMI) Professional Proctor must be willing to assist in these primary areas:

- Promote PMI certification courses via webinar or self study format in their community
- Promote PMI course presentations in their community
- Provide a location to Proctor PMI's certification exams
- Promote the ongoing monthly webinars
- Promote the Total Access subscription for webinars

Those who are eligible to apply for the role of proctor must have an active PMI credential.

Proctors are required to adhere to Practice Management Institute Standards of Excellence.

It is important to note that this is not a full-time position, and no relationship of employer/employee will exist between PMI and its Proctors. Proctors are compensated on an Independent Contractor basis.
